

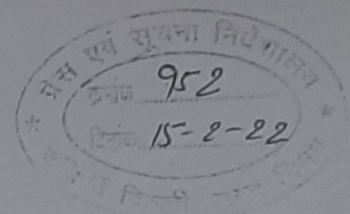

Sub: Minutes of Review Meeting (through VC) on Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) chaired by Hon'ble Lt. Governor on 11/01/2022 at 12 Noon

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Lt. Governor on 11/01/2022 (through Video Conferencing) to review the ongoing programmes and plans for celebration of 75th Anniversary of Independence - "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM)". The meeting was attended by the Addl. Chief Secretary (GAD), Addl. Chief Secretary (Home), Pr. Secretary (ACL), Secretary (ACL), Secretary (TTE/Higher Education), Director (Education), Chairperson (NDMC), Vice Chairman, DDA, Commissioners of 03 DMCs and other senior officers.

While referring to the meeting of the National Committee on AKAM, chaired by Hon'ble PM held on 22 Dec 2021, Hon'ble Lt. Governor advised the officers to make concerted efforts for celebration of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav as it was a matter of pride and honor for all the citizens of the country to be a part of the historic event.

Addl. Chief Secretary (GAD) made a powerpoint presentation detailing the progress made under AKAM by GNCT of Delhi. Hon'ble Lt. Governor emphasized upon the officials to ensure effective outreach and enhanced participation of children, youth and other citizens in the various activities being organized as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav by enhanced use of technology. Hon'ble Lt. Governor also suggested publishing a small booklet/brochure containing details of events and programs being organized by various departments of GNCTD under AKAM in vernacular languages so that community participation can be facilitated and enhanced as it was. It was also suggested to use the logo of ALKAM on government stationary to create wider awareness.

Principal Secretary (ACL) informed in the meeting that they have been conducting various online programs through all their academies. It was also informed that ACL Department has conducted surveys and research with the help of Archaeological Survey of India and will prepare a Program Schedule setting the timelines for the repair/maintenance of Monuments associated with the freedom struggle so that people get to know about the significance of the monuments in the Freedom Struggle of India.



Hon'ble Lt. Governor also inquired about the Freedom Fighters of Delhi who contributed to the Freedom Struggle and advised the ACL Department to provide assistance as required to the LG Secretariat in the initiative of publishing the chronicles of unsung (lesser known heroes of Delhi's Freedom Struggle).

Addl. Chief Secretary (GAD) informed that as per the recent DO letter from Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India, the department of PWD and MCDs have been advised to take necessary action and look into the beautification of Chaurahas.

Hon'ble Lt. Governor advised all the departments to strive to achieve 100% digital delivery of Govt. services by August 2022 as a befitting tribute to 75 years of the country's independence.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.


