CIRCULAR

Subject: Submission of Annual Immovable Property Return (AIPR) for the year - 2022 (as on 31.12.2022) by the officers of MCD – issuance of Vigilance Clearance.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule-18(1)(ii) of CCS (Conduct) Rule 1964, every government servant belonging to any service or holding a Group 'A' or Group 'B' post shall submit an annual return in such form as may be prescribed by the Government in this regard giving full particulars regarding the immovable property inherited by him/her or owned or acquired by him/her or held by him on lease or mortgage either in his/her own name or in the name of any member of his /her family or in the name of any other person dependant on him.

2. Further, attention is also drawn to DoP&T O.M. No. 11012/11/2007-Estt-A dated 14.12.2007, laid down guidelines regarding grant of Vigilance Clearance to members of Central Civil Services/Posts which inter-alia states that ***“Vigilance Clearance shall be denied to an officer if he/she fails to submit his/her annual immovable property return of the previous year by 31st January of the following year, as required under Govt. Of India decision under rule 18 of the Central Civil Service (Conduct) Rule, 1964.”***

3. Further, attention is also drawn to DoP&T O.M No.11012/11/2007-Estt. A dated 27/9/11 which stipulates that the ***officer who do not submit the property return by the prescribed time/date, would be denied vigilance clearance and will not be considered for promotion and empanelment for senior level posts in Government of India.***

4. It is worth to mention that the necessary instruction on aforesaid matter has already been issued by the respective erstwhile Corporations.

5. Keeping in view of aforesaid guidelines, it has been decided that henceforth no Vigilance clearance will be issued by the Vigilance department, MCD in respect of group A & B officers until the concerned HODs/DDOs asking for the vigilance clearance submit in writing that the officer for whom the vigilance clearance has been sought, has submitted his/her AIPR for the year 2022 received on XX/January/2023.

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6. Therefore, all Group 'A' & 'B' officers are advised to submit their AIPR to their respective Cadre Controlling Authorities for the year ending 2022 by 31st January 2023. In case, the officials fails to comply with the **deadline for submission** of AIPR, their Vigilance Clearance shall be **denied for all purposes**.
