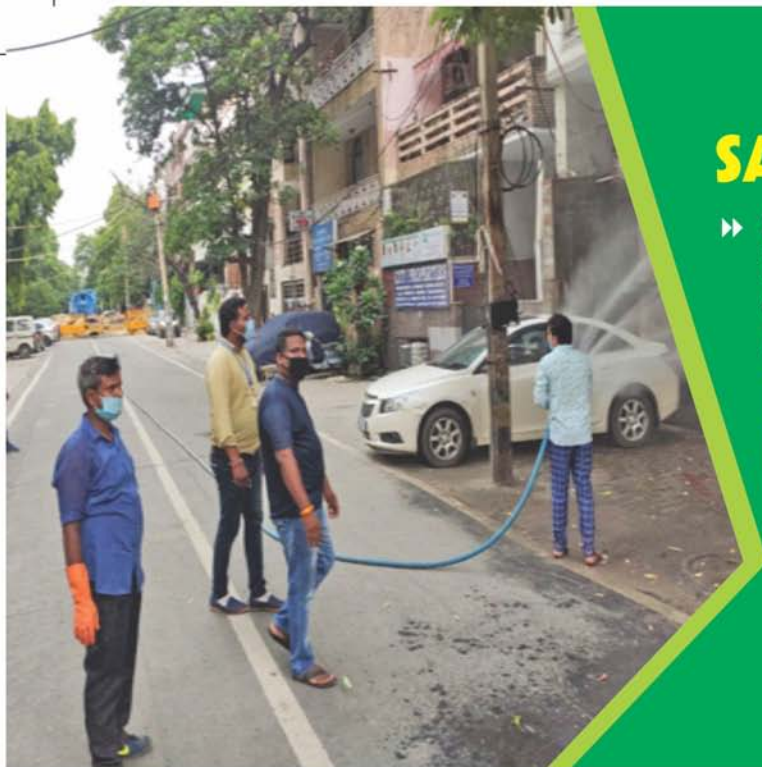

Prevention

MAINTAINING HYGIENE

- ▶ Prevention of any epidemic requires clean & hygienic surroundings
- ▶ Accordingly, SDMC with more than 22,000 Safai Karmcharis has been carrying out extensive cleaning of all areas which fall under its jurisdiction





SANITISATION/DISINFECTION

► Sanitisation plays a vital role in checking the infections. Accordingly, SDMC has been carrying out extensive sanitisation using various tools and resources:-

Motorised Pumps 400 **Pitthoo Pumps 893**

Tanker Sprayers 10 **Jetting Machines 16**

Water Sprinklers 16 **Drones 02**

► SDMC has sanitised 64,206 colonies, 54,894 Public places and more than 150 containment zones on daily basis. In addition 15 quarantine centres have been sanitised twice a day



DISTRIBUTION OF IMMUNITY BOOSTERS

- ▶ To prevent the spread of Corona, Ayurvedic and Homeopathic departments of SDMC have distributed Arogya Kadha to 1,57,516 people and arsenic-30 to 3,57,751 people to boost their immunity
- ▶ Ayurveda department has spread awareness and visited 3,74,315 people to educate them on how to protect themselves from the virus





SCREENING

To check the further spread of Corona virus, doctors & paramedics of SDMC, in coordination with Central and State government, carried out screening of passengers at

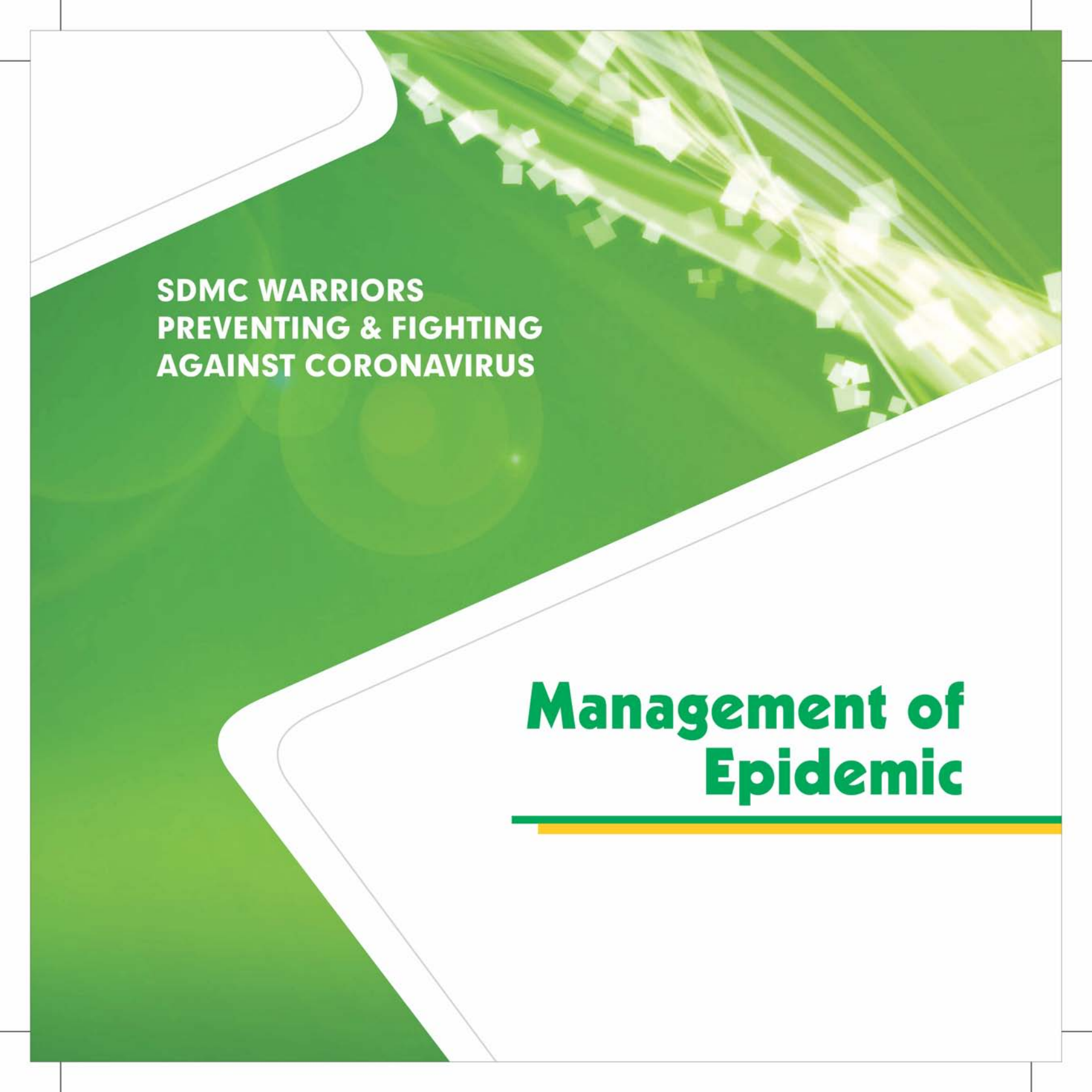
Airport | Bus stand

SURVEILLANCE

- » In close coordination with District Magistrates, 957 doctors and paramedics of SDMC carried out door to door surveillance to identify suspected covid patients
- » During this period 17,93,854 people in 5,77,047 houses were examined
- » Samples of suspected Covid patients were collected and sent to laboratories

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Management of Epidemic

TREATMENT

- ▶▶ SDMC runs more than 80 flu clinics on daily basis
- ▶▶ Through these flu clinics approximately 5,51,687 people were given OPD consultation and people with flu like symptoms were sent to hospitals for further medical management since 26 March 2020
- ▶▶ Two hospitals of SDMC viz PSMS Hospital Kalkaji and TNCH Tilak Nagar with their 50 and 70 bedded capacity are being utilised continuously. TNCH is being used as an Isolation Centre



SAMPLING

- ▶ **RT- PCR and Rapid Antibody Test for Covid19:**
Doctors and paramedics are involved in sample collection for RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen Test
- ▶ In close coordination with State Government, Sero-sampling survey is being carried out wherein, blood samples are being collected/taken from common people



QUARANTINE AND ISOLATION CENTRE

- » With close coordination with state government, SDMC manages more than a dozen of Quarantine Centers and 175 Isolation Centres
- » SDMC schools and community centres are being utilised as Isolation Centres
- » Doctors, paramedics and other employees of SDMC are involved in treatment, care, sanitisation and management of these Isolation & Quarantine Centers
- » Role and work of SDMC may be seen in successful management of Asia's largest Isolation Centre viz RSSS Chhatarpur
- » More than 10,321 people have been managed in quarantine houses so far



WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

- » DEMS Department of SDMC has continuously been involved in collection and disposal of solid waste from Isolation Centres, Quarantine Centres and Covid positive houses
- » With an approximate average of 32,00 MT per day, 3,87,381 MT of waste has been collected/disposed. In addition, 2,89,086 kg waste was collected and disposed off from Containment zones



BIO MEDICAL WASTE COLLECTION & DISPOSAL

- » Bio medical waste is being collected by SDMC staff from all covid positive houses and given to Common Bio medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) for disposal



HUMAN HELP

- ▶ South Delhi Municipal Corporation distributed cooked food and dry ration to the needy people in locked down situation. More than 32 food shelters, 70 cooked food centres and 70 dry ration centres distributed ration continuously
- ▶ SDMC in closed coordination with state government arranged a significant number of shelter homes so as to help the homeless people during this epidemic



COUNSELLING THE PEOPLE

A toll free number 1800115676 has been taken. Teams of SDMC Doctors and Clinical Psychologists from Private Sector have been roped in for running this Counselling Centre w.e.f. 15.04.2020





DATABASE OF PLASMA DONORS

- ▶ Doctors of SDMC not only treat the corona patients round the clock, they are also motivating its employees who recovered from Corona, to donate plasma
- ▶ SDMC has created a database of such prospective plasma donors, so as to save the life of other patients



Maternity Homes

- » Maternity homes of SDMC work 24X7 to provide maternity service and delivery facility to all mothers including Covid-19 positive mothers



HEALTH EDUCATION AWARENESS PROGRAMME IN COMMUNITY

- SDMC is running various Health education awareness programmes to make people aware about the right ways of protection against Covid-19



CREMATION GROUND

- » SDMC has provided dedicated Covid-19 cremation ground running on CNG for dignified & safe cremation

Do's ✓

Throw used tissues into closed bins immediately after use



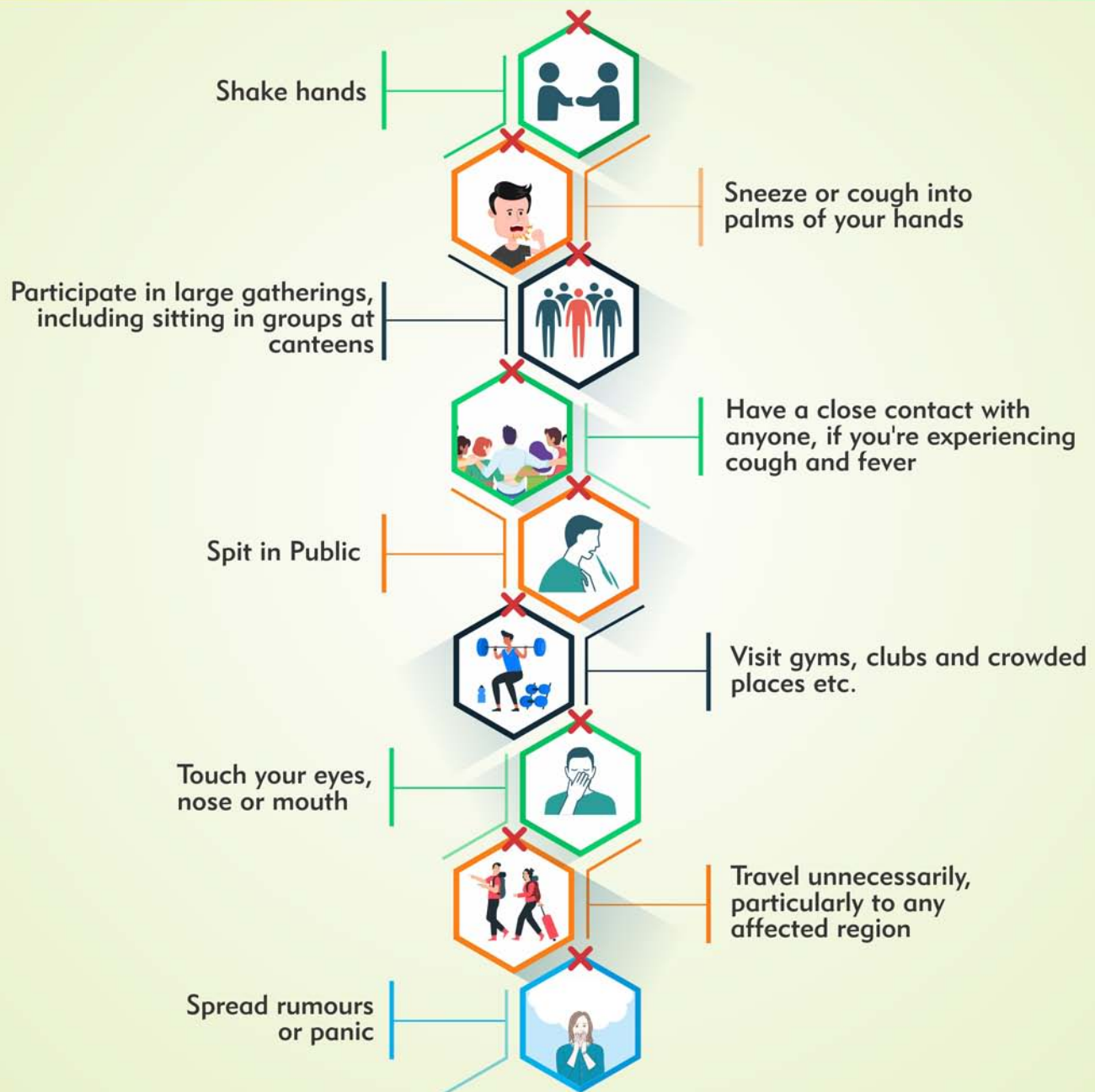
Sneeze in the inner side of your elbow and do not cough into the palms of your hands
