- **Note 2:** Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation (ISTC) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Govt. shall ordinarily not exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications.
