Policy for permission for installation of Small Cells and carrying telegraph lines on public land/street furniture owned and managed by MCD in its jurisdiction.

Communication of Ministry India, of Telecommunication) has notified rules to regulate underground infrastructure (Optical Government Fiber) and over-ground infrastructure (Small Cells) Rules vide Notification dated 15th November, 2016, which was published in Gazette of India on 16th November, 2016 as amended in 2017, 2021 & 2022.

Municipal Corporation of Delhi being a local authority is covered under the definition of appropriate authority and it can exercise the powers with respect to framing of policies, terms and conditions within the rules framed by the Central Government and conditions governing the license under section 430 of the DMC Act, 1957. The broad terms and conditions of the policy are as below:

(A) Small Cell:-

- a) The Small Cell can be set up on street furnitures like street light poles, CT/PT, Dhalao parking lots, and on public buildings, toilets, CTCs, community halls etc.
- b) The maximum area per Small Cell shall be 1 sq m (one square meter) (including the space required for guy wires /anchor wires etc.). The utilization of space beyond the above limit will be charged at existing rates of mobile towers i.e. Rs. 339/- per square feet.
- c) The charges/ rentals for installation of small cells will be as per table given below:

As prescribed in D	oT Rule
One time charge	Rs.1000/- per application
Compensation	Rs. 300/- per annum

- The telecom service provider/infrastructure provider(IP-I) should submit the advance fee for the entire permission period and Rs. 50,000/- as interest free security deposit. The taxes are as applicable.
- Application for grant of permission will be submitted by the telecom service provider/infrastructure provider (IP-I) having valid license from the Deptt. of Telecommunication, Ministry of Communications, Govt. of India through online portal of the Corporation/ DoT.

Usage of street furniture for telegraph lines (B)

The charges/ rentals for using street furniture for installation of telegraph lines will be as per Indian Telegraph Right of Way Rules, 2016; which is as below:

As prescribed in D	oT Rule
One time charge	Rs.1000/- per application
Compensation	Rs. 100 /- per annum per street furniture.

Establishment of Over-ground & Under-ground telegraph infra (C)

The rates for establishment of over-ground and under-ground telegraph infra (Both one-time & restoration charges) would be as per the Indian Telegraph Rights of Way Rules, 2016 for laying of over-ground and underground telegraph lines modifying the Weigh Leave charges policy of MCD (only for the purpose of telecom RoW). Rest of the conditions would be as per existing norms of MCD.
