CIRCULAR

As per provisions of Section 417(a) of Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957 (amended to date), Municipal Corporation of Delhi issues Health Trade Licence (HTL) to Fitness Centres (including Gymnasiums etc.) running in the conforming areas as per MPD 2021 falling under its jurisdiction. In super-session of all existing orders/circulars/guidelines issued on the subject matter. Health Trade License shall be issued in conforming areas in accordance with the following provisions/guidelines/technical conditions/terms & conditions etc. This is as per Clause 15.7.2 of MPD 2021 and Notification No.12011/8/2019-DDI, dated 16/03/2020 of Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Gol:

Documents required for Obtaining Health Trade License	 (b) This is under two categories: (i) Running on or before 16/03/2020: Operation of Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) running on or before 16/03/2020 shall be governed under: • Permitted on all floors. • Permitted in the basement subject to relevant provisions of Building Bye-laws, structure safety norms and fire safety clearance. • In case the use of basement leads to exceeding the permissible FAR on the plot, such FAR in excess shall be used subject to payment of appropriate charges prescribed with the approval of Government. (ii) Running after 16/03/2020: Operation of new Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) running after 16/03/2020 shall be governed as under: • Allowed only on Ground Floor and Basement. (c) Operation of new Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) in Commercial Centers is permitted irrespective of cut-off date (i.e. 16/03/2020) and is as under: Permitted in Commercial Centers i.e. Metropolitan City Center, District Center, Community Center, Local Shopping Center and Convenience Shopping Center. Proof of legal occupancy of premises; Site Plan; Partnership deed & NOC from partners in favour of applicant; In case of companies, applicant will be asked to submit the resolution; passed by the Board of Directors for issue of Health Trade License. Fire NOC in case of basement
4.	License Fee & Processing Fee	 License fee for New/Renewal/Late fee (if applicable) for Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) will be collected as per Circular No. PA/MHO-I/MCD/2022/97 Dated- 07.07.2022
5.	General Guidelines	 The activity of Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) shall also be subject to any other specific terms and conditions, as may be prescribed in the relevant status/acts applicable to it. It shall be the responsibility of the plot allottee/owner to make arrangements for parking so that the parking does not encroach/spill over on public land. Premises shall be structurally sound and kept clean. Sufficient space should be available between two

		 machines/equipment or treadmills for free movement of individuals using the machines/equipment or treadmills. Premises should be well lighted and ventilated with sufficient number of lights, fans and exhaust fans in the non-air conditioned premises. Adequate facilities for drinking water. No Smoking' signs to be displayed.
6.	MPD-2021 Provisions	 As per the provision of MPD-2021 under clause 15.7.3 (in regarding plot size (Subject to specific conditions mentioned succeeding Para) the minimum size** of the plot on which these activities shall be permissible, or streets of prescribed minimum ROW, shall be 200 sqm in regular plotted development, 75 sqm in rehabilitation colonies, regularized-unauthorized colonies, resettlement colonies, Walled City, Special Area & urban villages subject to the following specific conditions. Note: ** Variation of ± 5% in plot size may be disregarded.
		Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) (Other than those on plots abutting commercial streets) is permitted on all floors. It is also permitted in the basement subject to relevant provisions of Building Bye Laws, structural safety clearance. In case the use of basement leads to exceeding permissible FAR on the plot such FAR in excess shall be used subject to payment of appropriate charges prescribed with the approval of Government.
7.	Technical Conditions	 Trained & qualified instructors specialized in the field must be available. Certificate of training of First Aid to the Trainers First aid kit shall be provided. Advisory/Instruction regarding use of equipment should be displayed prominently. Fitness Centre (Including Gymnasium etc.) will not display/indulge in sale of any food supplements, foo products etc. Availability of toilet (separate facilities for ladies and gents in bigger units) with proper drainage system. Availability of facilities of separate changing rooms for ladies & gents (optional). Wash basin made of porcelain/stainless steel along with soap shall be provided. Continuous supply of safe water shall be ensured in the premises. In case of intermittent water supply, adequate arrangement of water shall be made.

- The floor and skirted walls shall be thoroughly cleaned daily.
- Customers suffering from communicable diseases shall not be entertained. The premises shall not be used for residential purposes not it shall communicate with any residential portion of the premises. No personal belongings like clothing, bedding, shoes etc. shall be kept in the premises.
- Non-compliance of any of the condition of license or infringement of any by-laws, rules & regulations made in this regard will be liable for actions like penalty/disincentive and/or suspension/ cancellation/revocation of license as deemed fit for the violations.

Non-compliance of above mentioned conditions shall be liable for revocation/termination of license.
