FOR POST MBBS DNB COURSES ADMISSION YEAR 2025**

6. Post Graduate Diploma, Medical qualification pass certificate
7. SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by competent authority, if applicable
8. Proof of MBBS/Post Graduate Diploma, Medical qualification recognised as per IMC act/Central Government.
9. Eligibility certificate from the concerned department duly verified from his/her service records (S.B./P.F) as per the proforma attached to be submitted as soft scanned copy duly verified by ACA concerned at email id:- achamcd@gmail.com by **01.02.2026**, hard copy in original to be submitted on the day of counselling attached as Annexure "A".

Guidelines for counselling are as below:-

I. The General eligibility conditions:-

1. Medical Officer who has satisfactorily completed period of probation and has rendered not less than 5 years of regular service including the period of probation under Municipal Corporation of Delhi (or in erstwhile NDMC, EDMC & SDMC) and is not due to reach the age of superannuation from MCD service within five years from the date on which he is expected to return to duty after expiry of the leave, is entitled to avail study leave. Medical officers on the study leave will be paid Leave salary as per CCS study leave Rules.
(Under Rule 50 of CCS (Leave) Rules,1972. according to OM No A.12034/03/2012-CHS-v dated 02/11/2012)
2. A Medical Officer who has completed his/her period of probation satisfactorily and has also completed 3 years of continuous service including the period of probation under Municipal Corporation of Delhi (or in erstwhile NDMC, EDMC & SDMC), is eligible to apply for Extraordinary Leave (EOL) for pursuing higher studies certified to be in public interest. According to OM No A.12034/03/2012-CHS-v dated 02/11/2012
3. The candidate should have obtained NOC from Competent Authority prior to appearing for NEET PG Exam. In case of procedural delay he should have applied for NOC well in time. The copy of NOC should be submitted on the date of appearing for counselling.

4. Medical Officer who has already availed benefit of study leave (for PG Diploma) will not be considered for grant of Post Diploma DNB seat reserved for In service Medical Officer before completion of mandatory duration of service mentioned in the service bond.
5. Medical Officer who has PG qualification in one specialty will not be considered for grant of DNB seat reserved for in service Medical Officer in another specialty.

II. General Conditions:

- During the period of course the fee structure, curriculum, leaves rules etc as prescribed by NBEMS from time to time will be applicable to MCD service doctors selected for pursuing DNB training under reservation policy for In service doctors.

- If any Medical officer joins In-service DNB seat then he/she will not be considered / relieved for the sponsored seat even if he/she has taken NOC for doing PG course on sponsored seat.

III. Leaving DNB course MID WAY

1. If any MEDICAL OFFICER drops the DNB course after joining DNB on a seat reserved for in service Medical Officer he/she will be debarred from availing the benefit of reservation of DNB seat for the entire duration of course & **he/she will not be granted any NOC for appearing in the PG entrance exam for this duration.** The said period for purpose of debarring shall be reckoned from the date of leaving the DNB Course mid-way.
2. The period involved shall be converted into /debited from regular leave standing at his credit on the date on which he proceeded to join such course.

3. If any candidate wastes In- service DNB seat by leaving course after joining, he/she will not be eligible for In service reservation of DNB seats in MCD in future. Such candidate will also lose right of seeking any study leave in future.

IV. Counselling:

- **13 POINT Reservation roster: Allocation** of DNB seats to the In-service doctors in MCD for admission year 2025 will be as per 13 points reservation roster.
- **Rounds of Counselling:-** Tentative date for final round will be **03.02.2026** and subsequent round for In-service doctors will be after mop up round of MCC/NBEMS counselling for central pool.
- **Undertaking from Candidate during counselling session:-** After this round of counselling the selected candidate will pursue the course . In case of vacating the seat after joining the final round of counselling the candidate will be debarred for entire duration of course.
- Scrutiny of application forms and selection for DNB course will be done as per NBE guidelines by the counselling committee of MCD.
- Decision of the counselling committee of MCD on the matter of seat allotment of reserved DNB seats to in service Medical Officers will be final.

V. BOND:

- As NBEMS requires Service Bond which will be applicable to candidates who join the DNB seats in Municipal Corporation of Delhi, it will be in the format as provided by Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievance & Pensions, GOI vide its Communication No. 11020/02/2023 – AIS- III dated 07-06-23 to be executed by officer proceeding on Study Leave under Rule 9(i) of the AIS study leave regulations 1960(**Annexure “B”**).
- The service bond is to be executed by Medical officers before proceeding on EOL to join DNB seat reserved for In-service doctors of MCD as per format at **Annexure “C”**
- Before joining the course candidate shall execute a service bond to the effect that he / she will serve in the Health department in the concerned specialty of Municipal Corporation of Delhi for a minimum period of 5 years after completion of PG degree / DNB degree Course and in default thereof to pay an amount equal 36 times of last pay drawn with allowances. The last pay drawn will be of the last month before joining DNB course.
- Decision of the Commissioner/MCD would be final in all other aspects.
