Quotations are invited by the Medical Superintendent, Hindu Rao Hospital on behalf of the Commissioner, MCD Procurement of Ophthalmic Lenses/Consumables for PMJAY admitted patients at Hindu Rao Hospital.

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**Terms and conditions:-**

1. The quotation should be submitted along with the required documents/certificates.
2. The rates quoted should be valid for a minimum period of twelve months.
3. The bidder should not be blacklisted or debarred in any govt. institution/department at the time of participation.
4. No firm will be eligible to withdraw its rates after the submission of the quotation/tender.
5. Rates quoted should not be higher than rates quoted to any other Govt. Hospital/institution.
6. Percentage of applicable taxes must be clearly mentioned. Also it should be clearly mentioned that the quoted rates are inclusive or exclusive of taxes.
7. The L-1 firm must ensure delivery of Ophthalmic Lenses at least one day prior to the scheduled surgery.
8. All supplied items must comply with CDSCO/ISI Standards or equivalent regulatory approvals.
9. Firm must provide rate for items as mentioned in Annexure "A". The rate of L-1 bidder will be fixed for one year and the concerned firm will provide implants for one year at the approved rates.
10. The L-1 firm must submit PBG/Security Deposit amounting to Rs. 50000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) in the favour of Medical Superintendent, Hindu Rao Hospital to be valid for 14 months from the date of execution of Agreement.
11. In case of non-delivery of required items within the stipulated time period, the required item will be purchased from the open market and differential increased cost, in any, will be duly deducted from any of his bill pending in Hospital and/or PBG/Security Deposit
12. Make and Model of the quoted item must be clearly mentioned in the submitted documents.
13. Samples/Catalogue must be submitted for quoted items.
14. The firm shall provide for transportation both ways, for the investigations that requires the presence of indoor patient in the laboratory. All consumables required for the investigation shall be provided by the contractor.
15. Payment will be made on submission of bill after verification from Nodal Officer PMJAY HRH.
16. The Medical Superintendent, HRH reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons.

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SUB:- LIST OF IOLS & CONSUMABLE FOR EYE SURGERY FOR PMJAY BENEFICIARY

**1. Viscoelastic Substances (OVDs)**

Used to maintain the anterior chamber, protect the corneal endothellum, and aid in lens implantation.

- Examples:
  - Healon
  - Viscoat

**2. Irrigation Solutions**

Maintain intraocular pressure and keep the surgical field clear.

- Balanced Salt Solution (BSS)
- Ringer's Lactate

**3. Surgical Blades & Knives**

Used for corneal incisions.

- Keratome blades
- Crescent blades
- Side-port blades
- Blades (No. 15)

(All are sterile, single-use)

**4. Sutures (if required)**

Though many modern surgeries are sutureless, they may still be used in complications.

- Nylon sutures (10-0)
- Prolene (9-0)
- Vicryl (6-0 / 8-0)
- Silk (3-0)
- Silk (6-0)

**5. Intraocular Drugs & Medications**

Used during or immediately after surgery.

- Lidocaine (intracameral anesthesia)
- Phenocaine
- Intracameral pilocarpine 2%
- Intracameral Moxifloxacin
- Eye drop Prednisolone acetate 1%

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- Eye drop Tropicamide with Phenylephrine (pupil dilatation)
- Eye drop moxifloxacin
- Eye drop Homide
- Eye ointment Atropine

### 6. Intraocular Lens (IOL)

The artificial lens implanted after cataract removal.

- Types:
  - Monofocal
  - Multifocal
  - Toric
  - EDOF

(Each lens is sterile and single-use)

### 7. Drapes & Disposable Surgical Packs

Maintain sterile field.

- Eye drapes with fluid bag
- Surgical gowns
- Gloves (non powdered)
- Instrument trays

### 8. Sponges & Wipes

Used for fluid absorption and cleaning.

- Surgical sponges (e.g., cellulose sponges)

### 9. Tubing & Fluid Management Sets

Used with phaco machines.

- Irrigation/aspiration tubing

### 10. Ophthalmic Dyes (if needed)

Help visualize structures like the capsule.

- Trypan Blue
- preservative-free triamcinolone

### 11. Sterilization & Prep Materials

Used before surgery.

- Povidone-iodine solution 5%,10%
- Providine -iodine scrub
- Sterile saline
- Eye prep kits

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## 12. Local Anesthesia

- Lidocaine
- Bupivacaine
- Adrenaline (if used)
- Paracaine eyedrop

## 13. Marking & Measuring Aids

Help in accurate muscle positioning.

- Sterile marking pens and sterile scales
- Calipers (reusable)

## 14. Antiseptic & Prep Materials

Used before surgery.


- Povidone-iodine (5-10%)
- Spirit swabs
- Sterile saline
