PROJECT "VIDYASTHALI"

Primary Education is an obligatory function of the corporation under section 42(r) of the DMC Act 1957. The aim of Education Department of MCD is to bring every child, in age group of 3 to 11 years to school. The National Education Policy, 2020 has also focused on the enrollment & retention of children in schools and improvement in the quality of education in schools. The Education Department is also governed by Delhi School Education Act, 1973.

Approximately 8.5 lac. children are getting education by more than 17,000 Primary Teachers, Special Educators, PET, Counselors, Art & Craft & Music Teachers in the 1535 schools at 1185 sites located in 12 zones of MCD.

Education holds the key to economic growth, social transformation, modernization and national integration. It unites all the children without any discrimination in regard to caste, gender, religion & racism, etc. Primary education forms the bedrock of development. It is in primary school that children learn foundational skills that prepare them for life, work and active citizenship.

Education department of MCD offers several welfare schemes & services in fulfilling the Right of Education & for all round development of children. The services are as follows:
