FINANCIAL OFFER

1. Rate for lifting and transporting C&D waste from various locations of South Zone of SDMC to disposal point will be **Rs. _____ per MT/km (Rs. _____ only per cum/Km) including of all other taxes but excluding of GST.** Being Municipal Services, GST is not applicable at present. However, if GST is imposed by the Government of India at any time during the contract period, the same shall be paid by the SDMC or reimbursed to the contractor by SDMC at actuals.

Minimum user charges to be collected per call from waste generators is fixed @Rs. 2000/- (Rs. Two Thousand only) to cover the fixed cost of operations. However, if actual user charges are more than the minimum user charge of Rs. 2000/- then actual charges will be applicable.

2. The fee/concession to be imparted to SDMC **Rs. _____ per MT/Km (Rs. _____ only per cum)**

3. User charges from Waste Generators will be collected as per the Rates quoted above. However, maximum amount of user charges to be collected by the contractor for various distances to point of disposal are restricted as given below:

4. The quoted user charges will be escalated @ 7% annually on the previous year user charges. Maximum amount of user charges to be collected will also be escalated @ 7% annually on the previous year user charges.
